2 (b) COVERED PERIOD DEFINED.—In this section, the
3 term "covered period" means the period beginning on the
4 date of the enactment of this Act and ending on the earlier
5 of—

6 (1) the date on which the President, in con-7 sultation with the Director of the Centers for Dis-8 ease Control and Prevention, determines that the 9 threat of COVID-19 has subsided such that a sus-10 pension pursuant to subsection (a) is no longer nec-11 essary; or

(2) the date on which the national emergency
declared on March 13, 2020, and relating to
COVID-19 is terminated pursuant to section 202 of
the National Emergencies Act (50 U.S.C. 1622).
