Secretary Austin,

It has been heavily reported news that the Pentagon is planning on mandating COVID-19 vaccines for all active-duty military personnel in the United States (US) Armed Forces. While defeating COVID-19 is a just mission, I would implore you not to institute mandates which are a clear violation of federal law.

As you know, the current vaccines being utilized in the U.S. and internationally lack full Federal Drug Administration (FDA) approval, with their use only being authorized under an Emergency Use Authorization.
