3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Vessel Response Plan
5	Improvement Act".

1	SEC. 2. SEARCH AND RESCUE NOTIFICATION REQUIRE-
2	MENTS FOR VESSEL RESPONSE PLANS OF
3	COAST GUARD-APPROVED COMMERCIAL VES-
4	SELS.
5	(a) In General.—The Commandant of the Coast
6	Guard shall modify subparts I and J of part 155 of title
7	33, Code of Federal Regulations, to require the vessel re-
8	sponse plans of Coast Guard-approved tank and nontank
9	commercial vessels to include the procedures described in
10	subsection (b) for use by the Coast Guard in the case of
11	a search and rescue mission.
12	(b) PROCEDURES.—The procedures described in this
13	subsection are as follows:
14	(1) A procedure for providing, not less fre-
15	quently than twice daily for the duration of a search
16	and rescue mission, notifications to family members
17	of the crew of the vessel with respect to the status
18	of the search and rescue mission, any injured crew
19	member, and salvage.
20	(2) A procedure for the immediate notification
21	of the next of kin or family members in the case

23	(A) a deceased crew member; or
24	(B) the recovery of a survivor or the body
