## Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Vermilion, Louisiana Portable, and Mobile Radio Upgrades project in the fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Vermilion Parish Sheriff's Office, located at 101 South State St., Abbeville, LA 70510. The funding would be used to purchase portable multiband radios and mobile radios. These radios would replace 15-year-old radios, which are no longer supported by the manufacturer. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because when the radios need repairing, parts are often unavailable, and the radio must be pulled from service. The lack of communications equipment is an officer safety issue. Many deputies have resorted to using their cell phones which are unencrypted and cannot interoperate with other first responders such as fire and EMS or other departments providing mutual aid.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by section 1701(b)(8) of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10381(b)(8)).
