A BILL

To amend the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act to extend the destruction authority of the Secretary of Health and Human Services to articles that present a significant public health concern, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- This Act may be cited as the "Destruction of Haz-4
- 5 ardous Imports Act".

1 SEC. 2. DESTRUCTION OF CERTAIN REFUSED ARTICLES.

- 2 (a) In General.—Section 801(a) of the Federal
- 3 Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. 381(a)) is
