PRISONS FUNDS.

(a) Development.—Not later than 270 days after

9 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Attorney Gen-

1	eral shall take such steps as necessary to develop a plan

3	(1) return the amount of funding issued to the
4	Bureau of Prisons to the amount issued to the Bu-
5	reau in fiscal year 2019; and
6	(2) structure funding issued pursuant to para-
7	graph (1) to the Bureau of Prisons in the following
